Directions and Parking

From US 50/US 301: Take the Rowe Blvd. South exit (exit 24) toward Annapolis (bear right) Stay on Rowe Blvd. past Navy Stadium. Take the next right onto Taylor Avenue and enter the stadium parking lot through Gate #5. **State Shuttles operate weekdays 6:30 a.m.-8 p.m.** Trolleys arrive and depart every five minutes during rush hours and every ten to fifteen minutes at other times. The cost for all-day parking is \$5 either payable to automated pay machine on-site or a booth cashier during business hours. There is no charge for the shuttle. Alternate Parking:

Gott's Garage, 25 Northwest Street, Annapolis 21401: From US50/301, take the Rowe Blvd. South Exit (Exit 24) toward Annapolis. Bear Right. Stay on Rowe Boulevard approximately one mile until the street branches right. Next, take a slight left onto Northwest Street. The garage is immediately on the right with signs that read "Visitor's Center." There is also an entrance on Calvert Street.
